Media Arts Production: Practiced, Employed, Developed M0-01: Program Summary

Media Arts Production: Practiced, Employed, Developed (MAPPED), is an applied production career acclamation and advancement program. Through MAPPED, CION, with funding from FedNor, provides work and training opportunities for Northern Ontario's media arts production crew members. The program is designed to supplement existing funding sources to expand and develop the local skills base across Northern Ontario. The key points of the program are as follows:

- Qualifying productions can receive partial funding for up to six (6) Northern Ontario crew trainees to a maximum of \$10,000 per production. In some cases, CION may approve projects at levels that exceed the stated maximum of \$10,000 and exceed the stated maximum of 6 northern crew members (trainees). Exceptions (up to \$20,000) can be made for productions that illustrate a significant impact to the sector and commitment to training. Production companies who wish to apply for funding above \$10,000 are encouraged to contact CION as far in advance of their production start date as possible and be prepared to demonstrate a higher level of impact for the MAPPED trainees and for Northern Ontario's film and television production infrastructure.
- Trainee applicants must be new or emerging in their respective positions; this means they can have no more than two (2) credits totalling six (6) weeks of experience in the position being applied for. The position must be an upgrade within a department or a lateral transition to a new department; please refer to full program guidelines and the Northern Ontario priority positions list.

• MAPPED funding may cover 25% of the trainee's wages on productions that also have funding for those wages from another public sector source, i.e. the Northern Ontario Heritage Fund Corporation (NOHFC). When added to the existing 50% salary coverage from the NOHFC, this combination of sources provides the MAPPED supported position with a total 75% salary coverage for each trainee. If a production is not receiving NOHFC funding, CION may provide different funding coverage which will be determined by CION on a case-by-case basis (to a maximum of 50% of the trainee's approved wages).
