

Driving Grid

Filming requests that involve vehicle-travelling shots must indicate clearly on the Location Filming Permit. A detailed map must be submitted with the application that includes the vehicle starting/end point; outline on the map the location and direction the vehicle will be travelling. If the location is unclear the production must make every effort to identify the parameters of where they will be travelling. A PDO will be required to escort any picture vehicles if travelling on a processing trailer. PDO will also be required if performing special effects or vehicle stunts during driving grid. Camera placement should not obstruct the driver's vision. Should any vehicle rigging exceed the width of a single lane a PDO will be required

Sketches to Include:

- Identify North direction
- Identify street names
- Identify location of production vehicles
- Identify movement of scenes, traffic/pedestrian interruptions, barricades, etc.
